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Report on Cyber Crime and Cyber Safety Awareness Lecture Organized under *CAWACH* Kendra Activities

20th September, 2025


The program commenced with a melodious prayer sung by the student-teachers of the college. The prayer created a serene atmosphere and set a positive tone for the day's program. It was followed by a moment of silence, symbolizing respect for knowledge, discipline, and the noble cause of spreading awareness about cyber safety. The Principal of the college warmly welcomed the dignitaries, faculty members, B.Ed. trainees, and the students from nearby schools of Petlad town. In her welcome address, she highlighted the importance of organizing such awareness programs in the era of digitization where every individual, from children to adults, is highly engaged with smart phones, social media, and online transactions.

Dr. Kamendu Thakar, senior faculty member of the college, formally introduced the guest speaker of the session, **ASI Shri Muktakim Malek**, Cyber Crime Police Station, Anand. - **Preventive Measures:** Practical tips for safe usage of the internet, like setting strong passwords, enabling two-factor authentication, and avoiding suspicious links or emails.
- **Role of Social Media:** How



youth must use social platforms responsibly and avoid oversharing personal information.

- **Legal Provisions:** Basic awareness about laws related to cyber crime in India, how victims can file complaints, and the

supportive role of police in such cases.

- **Digital Hygiene:** Daily practices like updating software, using antivirus, avoiding public Wi-Fi for financial transactions, and being cautious with online friendships.


The lecture was interactive, with Shri Malek presenting real-life cases of cyber fraud that had occurred in Gujarat. These examples gave the students a clear understanding of how cyber threats can affect anyone.
